

# Hope for the Dream.

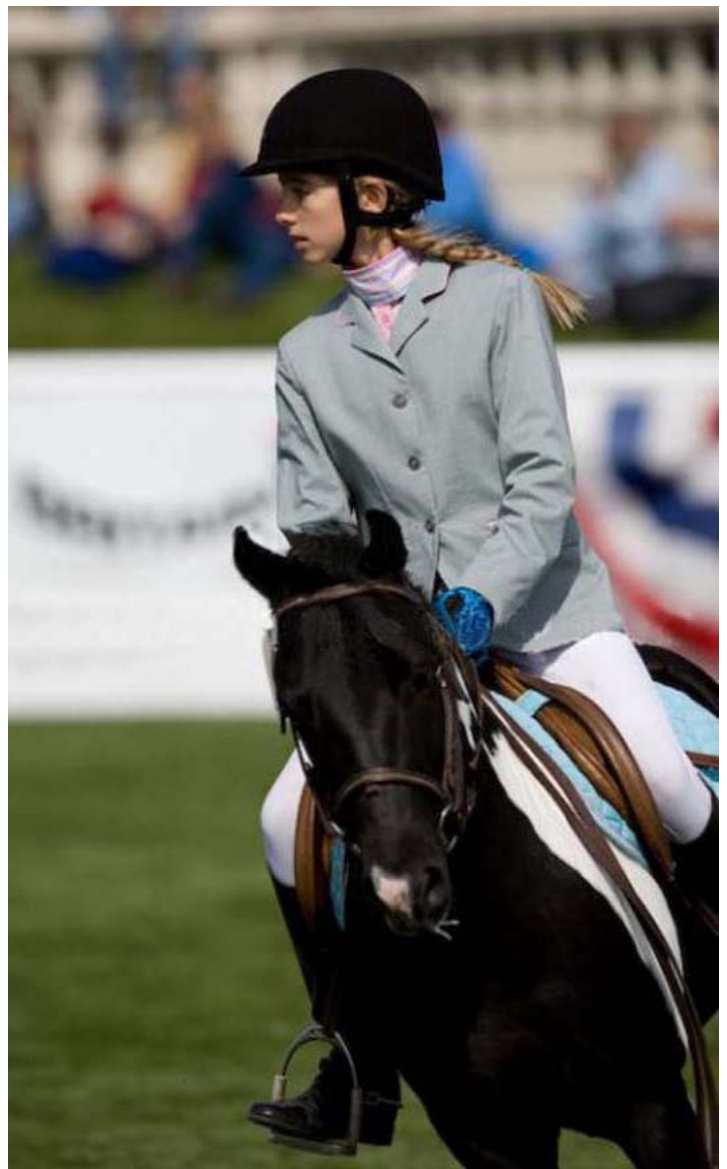
The dream for Hope started with humble beginnings on July 17th 1996 the first child of Dan and Joyce Enders, home was a one bedroom basement suite in Dover and there were no horses in sight. That was just 12 years ago. In the 12 years that have followed she has already done more on a horse than most people will in their whole life!

## *Rumor has it she started riding before she could walk...*

At the age of 5 she won most improved rider at the East Gate Saddle club. By the age of 8 she had won high point horse at the same club. Eight was also a big year for hope as she

instantly became a crowd favorite competing as *the youngest rider ever to enter The Spruce Meadows Masters, Battle of the Breeds* for Team Shetland Pony, her first international event. By the age of 9 she broke and trained her first Shetland pony to ride and drive, creating her first business, \$5 Pony Rides. She won The Pratt Memorial Trophy for High Point Jr. Rider, Hunter, at the Western Canadian Pony finals. She rode demos at the Calgary Stampede for Welsh Pony, and still found time to compete again at the Spruce Meadows Masters, Battle of the Breeds.

At the age of 10 Hope decided that it was time she trained her own pony, “Moose On The Loose” for the 2008 Spruce Meadows Masters, Battle of the breeds. ***Not only was she still the crowd favorite, she was asked for the 4th year in a row, by the head sponsor, to do the encore ride and placed in the ribbons against adults 3 to 4 times her age and horses 2 to 3 times Moose’s size.***

In 2008 Hope won the Children’s High Champion 3’6” Jumper and the open (against adults) 3’3” Champion in Tuscon Arizona at the HITS Shows In The Sun. Hope is currently training at 4’ jumpers, she rides at least 5 days a week and continues to be an A student.
